We oppose Rep. Josh Schriver's resolution urging the U.S. Supreme Court to overturn Obergefell v. Hodges

Detroit, MI – Log Cabin Republicans of Metro Detroit express deep concern and strongly oppose state House Resolution introduced by Rep. Josh Schriver, which urges the U.S. Supreme Court to overturn Obergefell v. Hodges, the 2015 landmark decision that legalized same-sex marriage nationwide.

"Freedom and individual liberty are cornerstones of conservative values," said Patrick Christie, president of the local chapter. "Any attempt to undermine the rights of loving, committed same-sex couples goes against the principles of limited government and personal freedom that our party stands for. The institution of marriage strengthens families and communities, regardless of sexual orientation."

Our chapter believes that government should not interfere in the private lives of two consenting adults. Overturning Obergefell v. Hodges would not only disrupt the lives of hundreds of thousands of married same-sex couples but also threaten fundamental constitutional protections.

"While we firmly respect those of faith that believe marriage is between a man and woman, Michigan Republicans must focus on policies that emphasize common-sense solutions to key challenges facing Michiganders such as reckless government spending under Gov. Whitmer, decline in job opportunities, and EV mandates that will only harm the Auto industry in our state-not revisit settled law to strip away rights," added Christie. "We urge the state Legislature to prioritize unity and freedom, rather than divisive and regressive measures."
